| Butterfly/Bee Name | Biology | What is it doing? (eg. flying, resting, feeding) |

| Australian Painted Lady | Butterflies dart close to the ground and eat nectar. Wings up to 5cm. Caterpillars feed on native daises. | |
| Blue-banded Bee | About 1cm long with metallic blue stripes. | |
| Common Brown Butterfly | Feeds on nectar. Caterpillars feed on native grasses. | |

| Butterfly/Bee Name | Biology | What is it doing? |
|-----------------------------|---|-------------------|
| Common Grass Blue | Pale purple-blue wings with grey underneath. Fly close to the ground, landing frequently to feed on flowers. | |
| Dingy Swallowtail Butterfly | Generally low-flying, often seen gliding. Feeds on nectar. | |
| Lesser Wanderer | Wingspan about 7-8 cm. Usually flies slowly from 1 to 2 m above the ground | |
| Meadow Argus | One of the first spring butterflies. Butterflies feed on native daisies. | |

| Butterfly/Bee Name | Biology | What is it doing? |
|---------------------|--|-------------------|
| Orchard Swallowtail | Wingspan to 10 cm. Feeds on nectar. Larvae look like bird poo! | |
| Red-spotted Jezebel | Common in Summer. Has bright red spots and splashes of yellow on bottom of wings. Eats nectar. | |
| Reed Bee | One of our tiniest native bees. Make nests inside stems of plants such as grass trees. | |
| Small Grass Yellow | Bright yellow with about 3cm wingspan. Prefers warm climates. Feeds on nectar. | |

| Teddy Bear Bee | Round and furry with a golden colour Up to 2cm long. | |
| Yellow Admiral | Begin flying in early Spring. Feed on nectar. | |
